



Personal Attendant Community Education

Personal Attendant Community Education (PACE) trains able-bodied persons to become Independent Living Attendants (ILA's) for people with disabilities. PACE is a recognized curriculum, developed, designed and delivered by people with disabilities to promote consumer choice and control in daily decisions that impact their lives. Follow-up surveys indicate over 90% success rate in obtaining employment in this field following graduation. Employment opportunities include Self-Managed Care, Home Care, private agencies, and Independent Living Housing.

The training is five weeks long. It runs Monday to Friday with classes from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM daily. Community training hours are early morning, afternoon and late evening.
